Most college athletes pursue careers outside of sports, just like you. They work hard to build their futures.

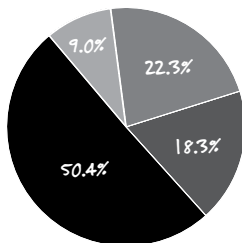
